GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Authors submitting manuscripts are requested to adhere to the following:

1. Originality, scholarly contribution to knowledge and should be written in English Language.
2. It should not be under consideration in any journal elsewhere. Once the manuscript has been accepted for publication, the copy right of such manuscript solely belongs to the FUDIJLSIM
3. The cover page should contain title, Author's name (surname should be identified by using a comma after the surname or written in capital letters), institutional affiliation, email address and phone number
4. The abstract of not more 250 words, single line spacing, followed by not more than 5 key words, the manuscript should be 12 font size, Times New Roman and double line spacing for the main work
5. Authors should also adhere to this format: Abstract, Introduction, Problem Statement, Objectives, Research Question or Hypotheses (optional), Methodology, Results and Discussion of findings, Conclusion, Recommendations and references
6. References should adhered strictly to the APA (6th Edition) referencing style.
7. Authors should submit electronic copy of their articles for initial assessment as an email attachment to fudijlsim@gmail.com or ssamaila@fudutsinma.edu.ng,
8. Article should be submitted with an initial non-refundable assessment fee of N5, 000 only while evidence of payment should be scanned and submitted with the article. If the article is accepted, authors will be required to pay a publication fee of N25, 000 or 100 USD only.
9. Each article will undergo blind peer-review by at least two experts
