FUDMA Journal of Arts (FUDJARTS) is a semiannual publication of the Faculty of Arts, Federal University Dutsin-Ma, Katsina State. It is an Intellectual sign post of the Faculty's commitment to avowed ideals of scholarship in the Arts and Humanities generally. Papers for publication must be written in clear unambiguous and concise English. **Typed double spaced with font size 12 in Times New Roman with 3cm margin.** All manuscripts must be original, analytical and not previously published in part or whole in whatever form elsewhere. **Manuscripts must not exceed 8,000 words including references. Authors are at liberty to adopt MLA or APA referencing style.** All papers submitted must bear authors names, affiliated institutions, and e-mail addresses. Manuscript for publication in the Journal should include in the main text **an abstract not exceeding 250 words, an introduction, main body and conclusion** depending on the type of subject covered or disciplinary orientation of the paper. All tables, figures, graphs, diagrams and photographs should be numbered and integrated appropriately.
